



HONOURING THE ICELANDIC HERITAGE

We are the only company in Iceland offering whale watching on traditional gaff rigged sailing boats. We play an important role in preserving the knowledge of handling and maintaining traditional sailing.



POWERED BY NATURE

North Sailing has taken a big step into making the fleet green by designing and building two electric boats that are silent and carbon-neutral!

DONNA WOOD

1918

Donna Wood is the Danish representative in our fleet. Originally built as a lighthouse ship, it underwent a massive restoration in 1990 equipping it with rigging and sails. Donna is now one of our frequent travellers, docking regularly in Iceland, Greenland and Svalbard.



HILDUR

1974

Hildur is named after the founder's mother, Hildur Jónsdóttir. As a tribute to her, this boat is traditionally referred to as "the grandmother" of North Sailing.



HAUKUR

1973

After having successfully served as a traditional whale watching boat in our fleet for five years, Haukur was renovated and transformed into a beautiful two mast schooner. A resemblance to the old shark and fishing schooners that were common around Iceland in the 19th century.



1951

Opal is the German representative in our fleet. It's the most technologically advanced vessel in the Icelandic whale watching industry! Powered by electricity or under sails, it's simply amazing sailing quietly on board the schooner.



BUILT ON TRADITION

The fleet consists mainly of traditional oak boats that were once common fishing boats in Iceland but are nowadays quite rare. By maintaining them we preserve cultural heritage. Nearly all the vessels have been restored and adapted to a new role without compromising their original character.



Why use oak boats?

Oak boats have many advantages to plastic and steel boats. Their robust build makes them strong, reliable and safe. The low fuel consumption rate makes them more silent and eco-friendly!



SÆBORG

1977

Sæborg is the newest and youngest addition in our fleet. Originally built for a local family in Húsavík, it is finally back home after years on the fishing grounds in the South. It always feels good being back home!



GARĐAR

Garðar is named after Garðar Svavarsson, a Swedish Viking who is believed to have been the second Scandinavian to reach Iceland. He settled down in the most beautiful place on the island, now called Húsavík!



NÁTTFARI

1965

Náttfari is named after Garðar Svavarsson's slave, Náttfari. He escaped as his master set sail towards what is now Scotland. He is believed to have been the first permanent resident of Iceland, in the 9th century.

KNÖRRINN

1963

Knörrinn was the first boat in Iceland to begin scheduled whale watching trips, so one could say it's been around the dock! Having survived the famous extreme weather in April 1963, it was nicknamed the "Lucky Boat", which has followed it ever since.



BJÖSSI SÖR

1975

Originally a whaling boat, Bjössi Sör has luckily gotten a new and better role. It's one of the last traditional oak boats ever built in Iceland, preserving the Icelandic cultural heritage. Bjössi Sör is named after Sigurbjörn Sörensen, the father of North Sailing's founders.



ANDVARI

1975

Andvari is an old Norse name meaning "a gentle breeze that glides silently through the air". It fits perfectly as Andvari is the fleet's second silent electric boat, and is ready to sail quietly with passengers to traditional whale watching areas.

Since the beginning of our journey, sustainability has been our key destination. We are proud to invite you on board Andvari and Opal, the only whale watching boats in Iceland powered by renewable energy!

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO **BE CARBON-NEUTRAL?**

A carbon footprint is defined as the totality of an organisation's CO₂ emission.

In order to become carbon-neutral, our carbon footprint is carefully measured by gathering data on all our activities. Using this information, we determine the total size of our emissions and set reduction goals based on reducing consumption and using a variety of low-carbon equivalencies and carbon offsets.

GREEN ENERGY

In addition to balancing our CO₂ emission, we're the only whale watching company in Iceland going the extra mile by offering completely carbon-neutral tours. Running on renewable energy, the boat doesn't emit any CO₂ as it is powered by green electricity.

REDUCE - REUSE - RECYCLE


We strive to make economical use of our resources and we always take environmental issues into account. We're committed to reusing and recycling materials, and disposing of waste in an environmentally sound manner.

Code of conduct

RESPONSIBLE WHALE WATCHING

We have to remember that whales are wild animals and to be able to visit them in the future we need to be patient and show them respect. We will try to get you close but how close we get is always on the animal's terms as we aim to minimise disturbance.

This is a Code of Conduct we aim to abide by. however, there are many variables to consider when out at sea, such as the weather, number of whales, prev availability, if there are calves present, animal behaviour and so on and so

Humpback whales can eat up to 1.5 tonnes of food per day.

Harbour porpoise 1,5 m & 70 kg.

Harbour porpoises are one of the smallest examples of marine mammals.

Puffin Lundi 24 cm & 500 gr.

Puffins can dive down to 60 meters underwater!

White beaked dolphin

Hnýðingur 3 m & 350 kg.

White beaked dolphins can reach a speed of 45 km/h.

Minke whale Hrefna 11 m & 10 t.

The Minke whale can create sounds at over 150 decibels that can be heard from many miles away. For comparison, loud rock concerts reach up to 125 decibels.

The Blue whale is the largest animal to have ever existed on Earth.
